WHEREAS, concrete masonry is versatile, durable, sustainable, and highly flexible, allowing architects and builders to create some of Florida's most beautiful structures; and

WHEREAS, concrete masonry is safe, fire resistant, and mold averse, providing optimal shelter from a wide scope of potential disasters; and

WHEREAS, concrete masonry is both green and economical, and it is a building material that can be recycled, reused, and lower energy consumption and costs; and

WHEREAS, the Masonry Education Act passed during the 2014 Legislative Session will provide a critical industry-supported Masonry Apprentice Program; and

WHEREAS, the Florida citizens who are proud to mine, manufacture, deliver, and install concrete masonry should be recognized for the important work they do;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rick Scott, Governor of the State of Florida, do hereby extend greetings and best wishes to all observing September 27, 2014, as Statewide Concrete Masonry Day in Florida.
